Online Application forms for admission into BNYS course for the academic year 2020-21 in the colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada are invited from the eligible candidates.

Note: The applications received in response to the common notifications (for admission into AYUSH [BAMS/BHMS/BUMS/BNYS]), dt.13.11.2020 & 29.01.2021 will be considered for admission into BAMS/BHMS/BUMS only. The candidates who have already applied for the same, have to apply again if they desire to take admission into BNYS course for the academic year 2020-21 as per the guidelines of Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi “that NEET is not Mandatory for admissions into BNYS course”.

Eligibility for BNYS Course:

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years as on 31st December 2020.
2. Minimum Educational qualification:
 - a. 10+2 Passed with Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) and English as compulsory subject.
 - b. 10+2 passed out from recognized board under AISSCE/ CBSE/ ICSE/SSCE/HSCE/NIOS/APOSS or other equivalent Board with Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
 - c. OC candidates should have secured 50% aggregate of marks in Science Subjects,
 - d. 40% in case of SC, ST and BC candidates.
3. The candidates who claim for admission under Persons with Disabilities (PWD) category shall mention in the online application that they are applying under PWD category and have to appear before a Medical Board, to be constituted for the purpose by the University, as per the schedule to be notified by the University for Eligibility under PWD status.

4. The eligible candidates as per the regulations who desire to take admission into BNYS Course in the following Private Un-aided Non-Minority Naturopathy (BNYS) colleges shall apply through online as per the schedule detailed above.

5. Application and Processing Fee:

- OC/BC Categories:- Rs. 3540/- (Rs.3000/-+Rs.540/-(GST@18%) plus Bank charges extra.
- SC/ST Categories:- Rs.2950/- (Rs.2500/-+Rs.450/-(GST@18%) plus Bank charges extra.

Note:-Application and Processing Fee once paid will not be refunded Under any circumstances.

6. Procedure of filling online application form and payment of fee through online

- The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.
- The fee paid by the applicants is not refundable under any circumstances.
- Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully regarding eligibility under local and non-local.
- Visit website through Internet Explorer 11 version only to fill the application form.
- The Registration number which will be sent to the registered mobile after entering the basic details, should be noted for further use. The Registration number should be kept confidential and should not be disclosed to others.
- Fill - in all the correct details in the online application form and upload all the documents including the certificates which are mandatory.
- The following Certificates are required to complete the online application process. The certificates are to be scanned and kept ready to upload. Application fee has to be paid through online.

7. Instructions to the candidates:-

- a. The candidates are advised to download and read the Prospectus of the course and instructions for filling Online Application available in the University Website <http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in> before filling the online Application.
- b. Scrutiny of uploaded data will be done by the University and officials from the concerned Departments. After scrutiny of scanned certificates, provisional merit list will be released and final merit list will be released later.
- c. The process of admissions into BNYS Course will be in accordance with the Orders issued by Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O.Ms.No.8, HM&FW(F2) Dept., dt.29.01.2021 and any other orders issued from time to time.
- d. The On-line application form with the following lacunae will be rejected automatically. No communication will be sent in this regard.
 - i. If any of the mandatory certificates are not uploaded.
 - ii. Applications with incomplete details / photo and signature.
 - iii. If any of the uploaded certificates are invisible/not properly uploaded.
 - iv. If the certificates are not properly scanned due to which the eligibility criteria cannot be determined.

- e. Due to Covid-19 and Pandemic conditions, the certificates verification will be conducted basing on the uploaded scanned certificates. No separate notification will be given for verification of Original certificates. The candidates claiming reservation under PwD category are advised to watch the University website for further notifications.
 - f. Hence, the candidates should register and upload all the mandatory certificates without fail and verify once again before submission of online application.
 - g. The candidate should submit the Printout of the filled in Online application form, Provisional verification form and all Original certificates along with One set of self-attested Copies to the Principal of allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment order will be cancelled without any notice. The candidates are informed not to send the print out of application form to the University.
8. Candidates admission is strictly provisional. The mere fact that the Merit position issued to him/her does not imply that his/her candidature is accepted by the University and it does not mean that the entries made by him/her in the online application are accepted as true and correct. An ineligible candidate obtaining Merit position does not make him/her eligible for admission.
9. The candidates eligibility for admission into BNYS Course for the academic year 2020-21 will be examined by the University officials and officials of the concerned department only basing on the uploaded scanned original certificates.
10. If the information furnished by candidate in the application is incorrect, his/her candidature is Liable to be cancelled and further action that deems fit will be taken. If the certificates produced by any candidate are found to be fake / false/forged at any stage of verification or admission, the University has every right to cancel the seat / admission of such candidate without any notice. In case of discrepancy in the downloaded provisional verification form, the same shall be brought to the notice of the University immediately.
11. Any orders that may be issued from time to time by University, Govt. of A.P. and CCIM, New Delhi with regard to Admissions will be applicable to this course.

Instructions regarding web options and allotment of seat:

1. Eligible candidates as per Provisional Final Merit Position (of applied candidates) should give ONE TIME OPTION for all Private Un-aided Non-Minority BNYS colleges in AP.
2. The Prioritized options which were exercised at the time of application will only be considered for allotment of seat. The same options will be considered for all phases of counseling. The candidate has to exercise options for Private Un-aided Non-Minority Naturopathy (BNYS) colleges in the order of Priority.
3. The options once exercised are final. No request for change of options or order of college priorities will be entertained after closure of web options schedule.
4. Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the web.
5. The same application will be considered for all phases of the counseling.
6. No further notifications for exercising web options will be issued.
7. Based on the merit list and order of priority of colleges, allotment letters will be released to the candidates, if seat is allotted.
8. Candidates will receive the message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are also instructed to visit the **website: <https://apbnys.apntruhs.in/>** for status of allotment
9. Candidate can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee through payment gateway. The students can login and view the college wise list of selected candidates in the website.
10. Candidates are informed to check their final allotment, take printout of allotment letter from the web and report to the respective colleges on or before the date specified on the allotment letter with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will lose the admission.
11. Any candidate allotted a seat and does not join he/she, shall not be considered for subsequent counseling.
12. Candidates are informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University Regulations.
13. **A. UNIVERSITY FEE:** Candidates to whom allotment message given have to pay Rs.8500/- before obtaining allotment letter through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).
B. TUITION FEE: The selected candidates have to pay tuition fee of Rs.22,000/- per year for admission into BNYS Course as per orders of Government of A.P. G.O.Ms.No.14 HM& FW (C1) Dept., dt.09.02.2021

14. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
15. Next Phase of counseling will be conducted for:
 - a. Open seats vacated by MRCs (Meritorious reserved candidates) who reported in same course will be filled up with the same category candidates.
 - b. Left over seats in phase-I Not reported/Not joined seats.
