Admissions into Management Quota seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority AYUSH (BHMS & BAMS) Colleges for the Academic year – 2020-21

Inviting On-line application forms and uploading of scanned documents for verification.

Applications are invited from the candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission into the Under Graduate Homoeopathy & Ayurvedic Courses under Dr.NTR UHS for the academic year 2020-21 for Management Quota seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority AYUSH (BHMS & BAMS) Colleges.

Qualification Criteria:

- i. The candidates who have already got admission through AIQ counseling of AACCC, New Delhi are not eligible to participate in this counseling. If it is found that an ineligible candidate participated in this counseling, candidature of such candidate will be cancelled and will not be permitted in further counselings.
- ii. Candidates from all over the country are eligible for admission into Management Quota seats of UG BHMS & BAMS Courses as per the regulations of CCIM/CCH / Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada
- iii. The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned State Government and Education Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually.
- iv. Minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of General category.
- v. 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.
- vi. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on **31st December, 2020.**

- vii. The candidates should secure the following cutoff scores in National Eligibility - cum - Entrance Test (NEET) UG -2020.

Registration fee:

1. The registration fee is Rs. 3,540/-(3000+540 GST 18%) + (Bank transaction charges extra), for all category students.
2. Fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to a further date.
3. Candidates are advised to check their eligibility before applying by reading Prospectus carefully.
4. The fee can be paid through Debit card/Credit card or Net Banking.

UNIVERSITY FEE:

Candidates to whom allotment message given have to pay Rs. 20,000/- before obtaining allotment letter through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/ Credit Card / Internet Banking).

TUITION FEE:

The selected candidates have to pay tuition fee of Rs.3,00,000/- per year for admission into BHMS & BAMS Course as per orders of Government of Andhra Pradesh G.O.Ms.No.159 HM& FW (C2) Dept., dt.23.12.2020 & G.O.Ms.No.14 HM& FW (C1) Dept., dt.09.02.2021

Procedure of filling online application form and payment of fee through online:

- a. The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.
- b. The fee paid by the applicants is not refundable under any circumstances.
- c. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully regarding eligibility under local and non-local.
- d. Visit website through Internet Explorer 11 version only to fill the application form.
- e. The Registration number which will be sent to the registered mobile after entering the basic details, should be noted for further use. The Registration number should be kept confidential and should not be disclosed to others.
- f. Fill - in all the correct details in the online application form and upload all the documents including the certificates which are mandatory.
- g. The following Certificates are required to complete the online application process. The certificates are to be scanned and kept ready to upload. Application fee has to be paid through online.

Instructions to the candidates:-

1. The candidates are advised to download and read the Prospectus of the course and instructions for filling Online Application available in the University Website <http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in> before filling the online Application.
2. The process of admissions into AYUSH (BHMS/BAMS) Courses will be in accordance with the Orders issued by Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O.Ms.No.8, HM&FW(F2) Dept., dt.29.01.2021 and any other orders issued from time to time.
3. The candidates should register and upload all the mandatory certificates without fail and verify once again before submission of online application.
4. Candidates admission is strictly provisional. The mere fact that the Merit position issued to him/her does not imply that his/her candidature is accepted by the University and it does not mean that the entries made by him/her in the online application are accepted as true and correct. An ineligible candidate obtaining Merit position does not make him/her eligible for admission.
5. If the information furnished by candidate in the application is incorrect, his/her candidature is Liable to be cancelled and further action that deems fit will be taken. If the certificates produced by any candidate are found to be fake / false/forged at any stage of verification or admission, the University has every right to cancel the seat / admission of such candidate without any notice. In case of discrepancy in the downloaded provisional verification form, the same shall be brought to the notice of the University immediately.
6. Any orders that may be issued from time to time by University, Govt. of A.P. and CCIM, New Delhi with regard to Admissions will be applicable to this course.

Instructions regarding web options and allotment of seat:

1. Eligible candidates should give ONE TIME OPTION for Management Quota seats in all Private Un-aided Non-Minority Homoeopathy & Ayurvedic colleges in AP along with application.
2. The Prioritized options which were exercised at the time of application will only be considered for allotment of seat. The same options will be considered for two phases of counseling. The candidate has to exercise options for Management Quota seats in all Private Un-aided Non-Minority Homoeopathy & Ayurvedic colleges in the order of Priority.
3. The options once exercised are final. No request for change of options or order of college priorities will be entertained after closure of web options schedule.
4. Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the web.
5. The same application will be considered for two phases of the counseling.

6. No further notifications for exercising web options will be issued.
7. Merit list will be released based on the NEET (UG) -2020 ranking & other eligibility criteria.
8. Based on the merit list and order of priority of colleges, allotment letters will be released to the candidates, if seat is allotted.
9. Candidates will receive the message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are also instructed to visit the **website: <https://apbahnumq.apntruhs.in>** for status of allotment.
10. Candidate can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee through payment gateway. The students can login and view the college wise list of selected candidates in the website.
11. Candidates are informed to check their final allotment, take printout of allotment letter from the web and report to the respective colleges on or before the date specified on the allotment letter with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will lose the admission.
12. Candidates are informed that verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University Regulations.
